- On July 21, 2010, the Hawaii Republican Party notified, via email, the Elections Office of its nomination of Harry Williams as the replacement candidate for the 14th District.
 On July 22, 2010, at 8:15 a.m., Harry Williams timely filed his nomination

papers to run as the Republican candidate for the 14th District.

9. Harry Williams is a candidate for the 14th District.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction over this matter.
- When the County Clerk accepted and filed the nomination papers submitted by David Hamman for the 14th District, David Hamman became an official candidate for the 14th District.
- David Hamman appropriately withdrew his candidacy for the 14th District.
 See HRS 11-117.
- Once David Hamman withdrew, the Chief Elections Officer gave notice to the Republican Party to submit a replacement candidate within the deadlines described under HRS 11-118(b).
- The Republican Party submitted notice of the replacement candidate, Harry Williams, to the Chief Elections Officer via email within the allotted time frame of HRS 11-118.
- Harry Williams timely filed his nomination papers as the replacement candidate.
- 7. Harry Williams is a candidate representing the Republican Party for the office of State House of Representatives, District 14.

III. ORDER DISMISSING PLAINTIFF'S VERIFIED COMPLAINT

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Plaintiff's verified complaint is DISMISSED.
